First thing in the morning the teachers open the doors and it is time to come in.








Inside will be waiting more lovely people to say hello to.

What are you doing up there, Mr Squeak?




We can learn with our friends or by ourselves.

We love stories at Menston and we read books every day. Which is your favourite?




I hope you like drawing, painting and making things because we do this all the time in school.
