We are keeping our coats on the back of our chair, so you won't need to go to your peg. You'll find out where to sit when you arrive at school.




If you are in Oak Class we will be learning in Oak Class and outside the back of Foundation next week. (Mrs Stuttard needs a lot of help with the gardening.)
