They score above 90 on the scaled score in assessments when the programme has finished.	As part of the National Tutoring Programme, baseline assessments are carried out, lessons are tailored to children's gaps and there is ongoing monitoring. To put English catch-up tutoring in place for identified children in KS2.	Employ a teacher to tutor identified pupils across KS2 on two days every week. This teacher will plan and deliver catch up lessons based upon children's identified gaps in English (from GL Assessments). This teacher will liaise closely with class teachers to ensure that this tutoring complements the work that the children are doing in class.	SLT Teacher employed for Catch up tutoring. KS2 class teachers.	Identified children in Y3, 4, 5 and 6 access high quality tutoring and their gaps are narrowed. They score above 90 on the scaled score in assessments when the programme has finished.	Catch up tutoring teacher to regularly review children's progress and report to SLT. Catch up tutoring teacher to amend/ adapt tutoring focus as appropriate.	From December 2020 until July 2021	Cost to school of employing teacher for 2 days per week plus PPA time from December for the rest of the academic year is approximately £15,000
For children in Y3 who have identified gaps in English that have been caused by missing school during lockdown to access high quality English tutoring delivered by our own staff.	Employ a highly qualified Teaching Assistant to work in Y3. This TA to work alongside Catch up tutoring teacher to deliver high quality English tutoring to identified Y3 children until the end of January 2021, then this TA takes on this tutoring with these children. This TA works in Y3 day to day, so is best placed to align this tutoring with class work for the highest possible impact.	Teacher employed for Catch up tutoring. TA employed to work in Y3 Y3 class teachers	Identified children in Y3 access high quality tutoring and their gaps are narrowed. <p>Maths tutoring:</p> <p>Five 1:3 face to face tutoring programmes and eleven 1:2 face to face tutoring programmes booked through White Rose Tutoring programme for children in Y2 – Y6. Total cost is £4545 for a total of sixteen 15-hour programmes.</p> <p>£1215 remaining for maths tutoring programmes in the summer term for children that are identified within the spring term (this will buy three 1:3 face to face programmes and one 1:2 programme).</p>
