

Menston Primary School Attainment Summary 2021 -2022

Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

EYFS outcomes in 2022 (formal end of EYFS assessment grades) and 2021 (Teacher Assessment grades) compared with 2019 (pre-pandemic formal end of EYFS assessment grades). Statutory assessments were cancelled in both 2020 and 2021 and in both of these years, children were affected by periods of school and Early Years provision closures.

Phonics

Year 1 children did not take the Phonics Screening Check in the summer term in 2020 or 2021. Instead they took the check in the second half of the autumn term when they were in Year 2. The 2021/ 2022 cohort of Y1 children took the Phonics Screening Check in the summer term 2022. The pass mark in 2022 was 32/40 – the same as in previous years.

Three children have entered Key Stage Two without passing the Phonics Screening Check in 2022. These three children access phonics interventions through the Essential Letters & Sounds programme.
