I would like to take this opportunity to share some updates and reminders.

Online Safety

We have re-written our online safety policy and I have attached a copy of the new policy along with this letter. The policy is published on our website here and a paper copy can also be requested from our school office. The policy, as well as the online safety page of our school website, contains useful links for parents to help to keep children safe online. Later this week, children will bring home a paper copy of the acceptable use agreement which forms part of the policy. Please can we ask that you talk this through with your child(ren) and return a signed copy to school by Friday 13 January. Copies will also be available to sign at our next parent consultation meetings.

Ofsted Inspection

We are anticipating that we will be inspected later this term (before Easter). As part of the inspection, Ofsted will ask parents to share their views of the school through an online questionnaire. We would very much appreciate it if parents could share any constructive feedback to the school through a questionnaire prior to the inspection so that we can continually improve our service to our children and families. In response to the parent survey carried out by governors in the summer term, we have made several improvements around key issues raised including communication, extra-curricular clubs, homework and behaviour management in UKS2. We have created a Google Form questionnaire for parents to complete. This form contains the questions exactly as they will be presented in the Ofsted pre-inspection questionnaire. We would very much appreciate it if parents could find time to complete the questionnaire so that we can gather your views on what is going well and information which will help us to continue to improve. Please could you complete a separate questionnaire for each child. Thank you.

Term dates and attendance

Please see the <u>Term Dates</u> page of our school website for term and holiday dates. An additional national bank holiday has been announced for Monday 8 May for the King's coronation. This means that Year 6 SATs will now take place from Tuesday 9 May to Friday 12 May. Please can families avoid booking holidays that impact on term-time attendance and learning. Children should only be absent from school if they are too ill to attend or for other truly exceptional circumstances.

School start and finish times

A reminder that gates are open between 08:45 and 08:55 and then between 3:15 and 3:25 for drop off and collection. Gates will close promptly at 08:55 and at 3:25 so that the site is secure for the start of the school day and for Care Club after school. Anyone arriving later than 08:55 will need to sign in at the main office please. Please be aware that this disrupts the efficient running of the school, as the admin team need to manage late arrivals which takes them away from their other important work.

Uniform
