Specialist Support for SEND

At MPS, we believe passionately in inclusion for all and we are constantly looking for ways in which we can further improve our offer for all children. This year, we have been lucky enough to secure some additional support from two specialist teachers who work as part of Bradford's Social, Communication, Interaction and Learning (SCIL) Team. Fiona Whitaker is a specialist teacher for cognition and learning and will be supporting staff and children with additional strategies for learning needs such as dyslexia and processing difficulties. Sharon Carr is a specialist teacher for Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) needs. Sharon will be supporting us in continuing to develop our provision for children who may be struggling with areas such as self-regulation, emotional literacy, anxiety and worry.
