SEND update

Just before the Christmas break, the teaching staff received some training from the Speech and Language Team at Airedale around selective mutism. If you are concerned about your child being a reluctant communicator, please read the helpful guide which has been uploaded to our website here. As part of the support from the Social Communication Interaction & Learning (SCIL) Team which was detailed in last week's newsletter, we have also had some updated dyslexia awareness training.
