In the summer term of 2022 KS1 classes took part in a special edition Junior Forester Award in partnership with the Queen's Green Canopy for Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee. The final part of the award was planting trees in our community which could not take place until the winter, so in January this year, the now year 2 & year 3 classes, went to Porritt's field in the village to plant some Woodland Trust tree saplings. The field has recently been taken over by Menston Area Nature Trust to improve this community field for the benefit of wildlife. The children each planted two saplings to create a mixed hedgerow and a small copse area. To celebrate this the children were all presented with a commemorative 50 pence piece from



the Royal Mint. The presentation was made this morning in the KS1 assembly by the Vice Lord Lieutenant of West Yorkshire.


