Miss Lain teaches Oak Class.



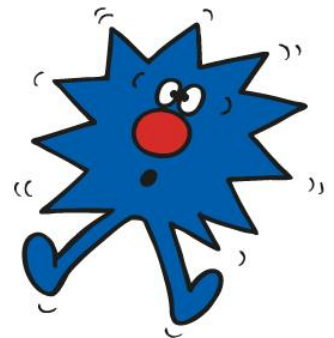
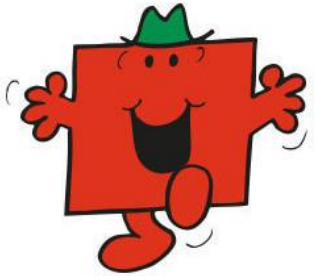
Here I am hanging out with my friend Mr Squeak!
He lives in Acorn Class.



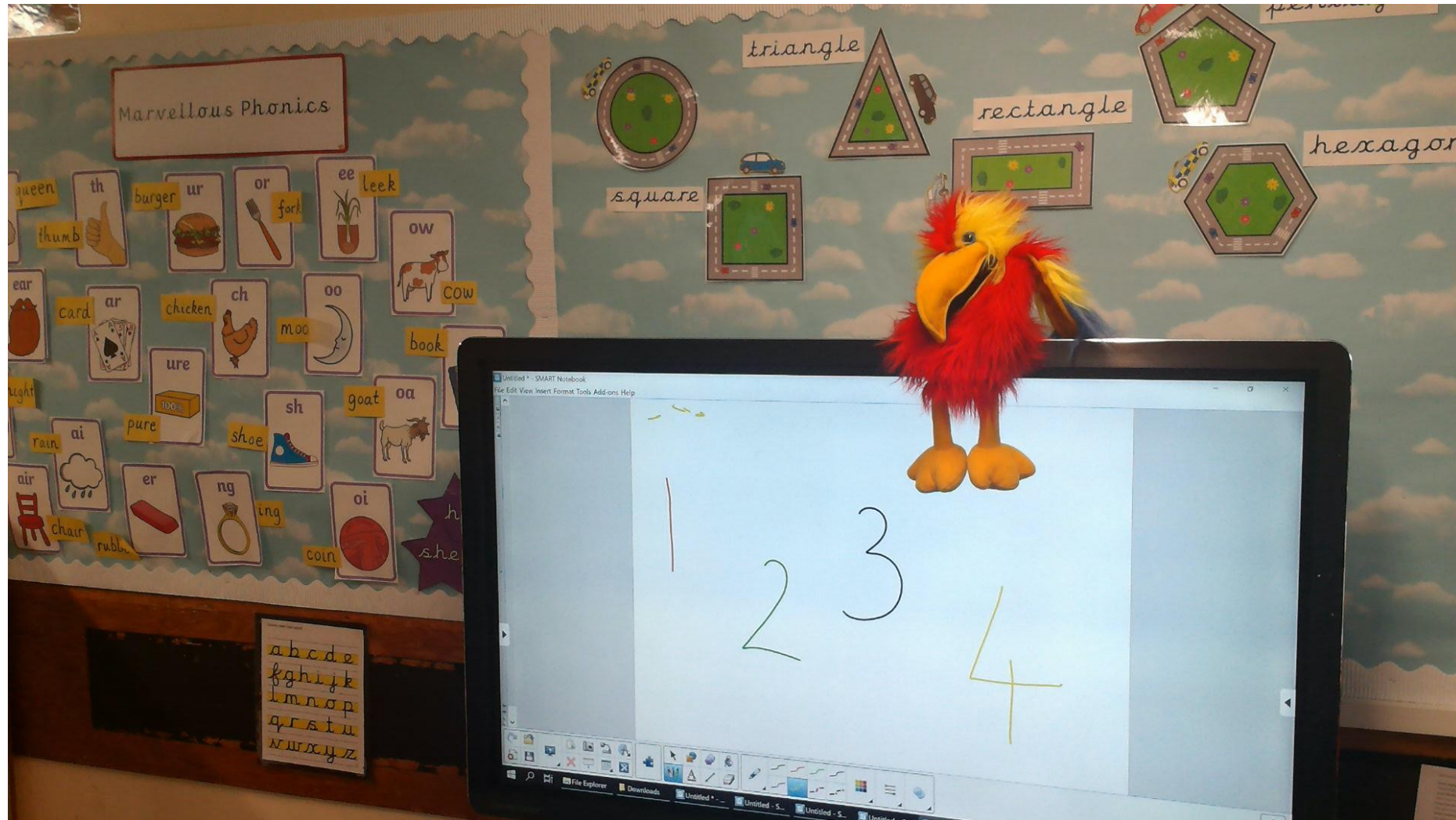
First thing in the morning the teachers open the doors and it is time to come in.

What are you doing up there, Mr Squeak?



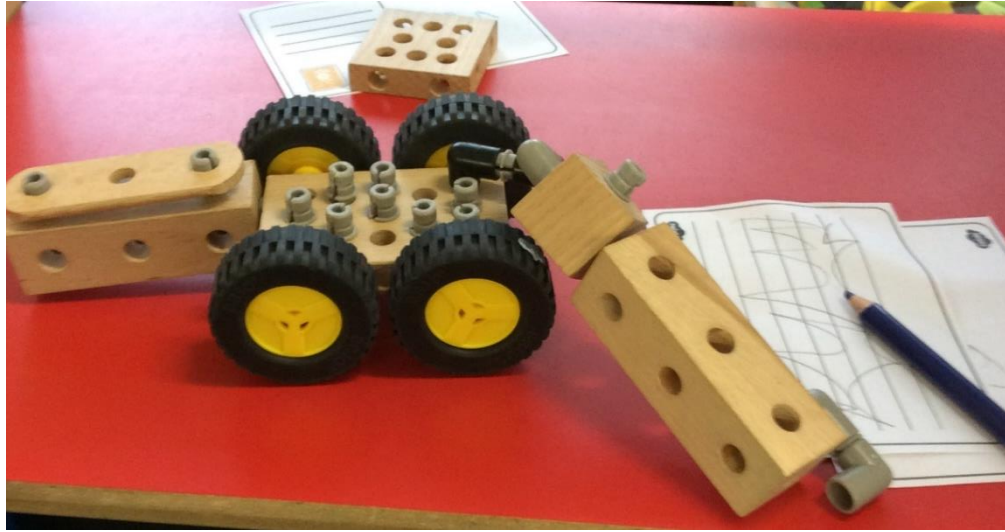
We can learn with our friends or by ourselves.
