Bradford Council has launched a consultation on the introduction of a 20mph zone for Menston. The Traffic and Highways (North) Team at the council want to find out what local residents think about the proposed traffic measures for the village. The proposals include a village-wide 20mph zone with supporting traffic calming features on entrances to the zone and on the main through-routes.
