It is lovely to see how well the children are settling into their new classes. Children are already becoming more independent in their learning and in remembering our school routines and expectations.

Please can families check the <u>School Uniform page</u> of our website to ensure that children come to school wearing the correct uniform. This includes PE uniform on children's PE days. We have noticed some children wearing footwear that does not fit with our uniform policy—a copy of which can be downloaded from the <u>policies page</u> of our website or requested from the school office. School shoes should be plain black shoes or ankle boots suitable for climbing and outdoor activities and PE footwear should be plain dark (navy blue or black) trainers. We encourage our families to donate outgrown uniform that is in excellent condition to our PTA, Friends of Menston Primary School. Parents can then buy high-quality pre-worn uniform items for as little as £1:00. Uniform can be donated/ purchased by contacting the school office or by seeing Mrs Meakin at the gate on St Peter's Way at drop-off and pick-up times. Some families may be eligible for financial support with uniform costs. If you think that this may apply to you, please call our office and ask to speak to Mrs Belinda Smitheringale. All calls will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have access to free fruit every day. Children in KS2 can bring fresh fruit, dried fruit or fresh vegetables for morning snack. We teach children about healthy, balanced diets, so would like to thank families for avoiding sending full-size chocolate bars in children's packed lunches. Thank you also for avoiding sending foods containing nuts and other known allergens into school.
