The choir will be performing at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints on Burley Road in Menston this evening at 7pm. If you are able to go along, you will be sure to have a highly entertaining evening.

The choir is touring the UK to raise awareness of the charity Educate the Kids and here at MPS we are keen to make an ongoing connection with the charity, whose mission is to provide as many children as possible in Mombasa with the education that they are entitled to with the aim that this helps to free them from poverty. We have donated some uniform and books to the charity in the past, but the cost of transporting physical items between the UK and Kenya is, as you can imagine, ever increasing. We will therefore be committing to sharing a portion of monies raised from any fundraising that we do this year to supporting the charity.
