### **Attendance**

In February, the government updated its guidance 'Working together to improve school attendance' and this guidance will become statutory from 19 August 2024.

It is important that parents have a clear understanding of fining around children missing school for reasons that are classed as unauthorised. Currently, it's the responsibility of the local authority to decide when to issue fines to parents, meaning the process varies from council to council. However, the new framework will ensure greater national consistency. From August 2024 the fine for unauthorised school absences which meet the criteria set out in the guidance will be £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days.
