School Timings from September

A reminder that the current Government requires all schools to deliver a 32.5 hour school week from September 2024. We have consulted with all stakeholders around our proposals for achieving this and have made adjustments to our school start times from September 2024. Our school start time will be 08:45 from the start of term in September, which will mean that our ten-minute drop-off window will be at the earlier time of 08:35 to 08:45. Gates and doors will all close at 08:45 so that lessons can start promptly. We are reminding families about this now so that you have the opportunity to consider how the change might affect your family and make adjustments to your own arrangements.

EYFS Mosque Visit

Reception Classes had a fantastic visit to the Madni Jamia Masjid mosque in Bradford on Monday. They looked at the minarets, dome and crescent moon outside and talked about the call to prayer. They learnt that Muslims enter a mosque with their right foot first. The children took their shoes off and put them on the rack. They learnt all about wudu, why and how Muslims wash before praying or reading the Qur'an. The children then went into the prayer hall. They looked at the prayer mats, the special seat where the imam sits called

the minibar, the mihrab which shows people the direction of prayer, today's prayer times, a model of the Kaaba in Mecca and prayer beads. The children learnt that Muslims pray five times a day and were shown how Muslims pray. The children were very respectful, and the visit really developed their understanding of mosques, and they learnt more about the Muslim faith.
