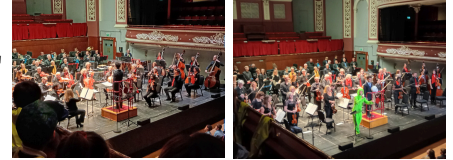

## Menston Juniors Football Club

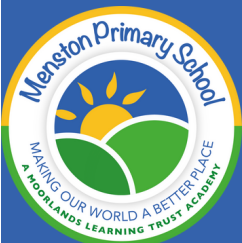
