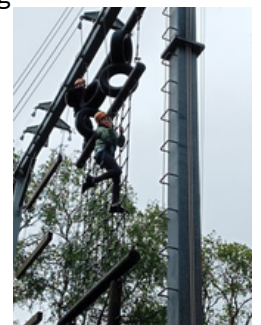

Yorkshire Dyslexia Festival

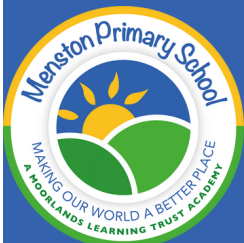
