As we move towards the final weeks of the academic year, we are beginning to prepare for transition and to support all pupils in feeling confident and ready for September.

Our whole-school transition morning will take place on Tuesday 30 June, when children will spend time in their new classes with their next class teachers. **On the same day, we are pleased to invite you to our 'Meet the Teacher' event, which will run after school until 4:15pm.** This will be an opportunity to visit your child's new classroom and meet their teacher ahead of the new academic year. We will share information about class arrangements in advance so that families are well-prepared for these events.

For our new Reception starters, our Reception team have planned a full programme of transition activities to support children in settling into school. Information will continue to be shared directly with families over the coming weeks to ensure you feel fully prepared for September.

For our Year 6 families, secondary school transition events will be taking place throughout June and July. You should already have received communication from your child's secondary school with specific details. If you have any questions or need to check information, please do not hesitate to contact either ourselves or the secondary school directly.

We would also like to remind you that annual reports will be sent out on Tuesday 7th July. These provide an important opportunity to celebrate your child's progress and achievements over the year.

Northern Rail

Train operator Northern has launched a new scheme to help children get confident on the train ahead of the big secondary school move. The new 'Settling In' ticket will offer one free adult and child day ticket, valid anywhere on the Northern network, to families whose Year 6-age child is moving from primary to secondary school this autumn. The free tickets will allow a parent or guardian to travel by train with their child to their new school induction day, so that they can practice the journey to school and get comfortable travelling by train. To claim the tickets, parents and guardians should complete the online form by [clicking here](#). Once submitted, a unique code will be issued which can be used to book the free day tickets online. Availability is limited to one application per child. The free day ticket covers one adult and one child travelling together on Northern services.

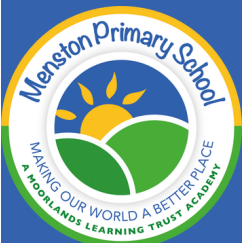
