Northern Rail

Train operator Northern has launched a new scheme to help children get confident on the train ahead of the big secondary school move. The new 'Settling In' ticket will offer one free adult and child day ticket, valid anywhere on the Northern network, to families whose Year 6-age child is moving from primary to secondary school this autumn. The free tickets will allow a parent or guardian to travel by train with their child to their new school induction day, so that they can practice the journey to school and get comfortable travelling by train.
